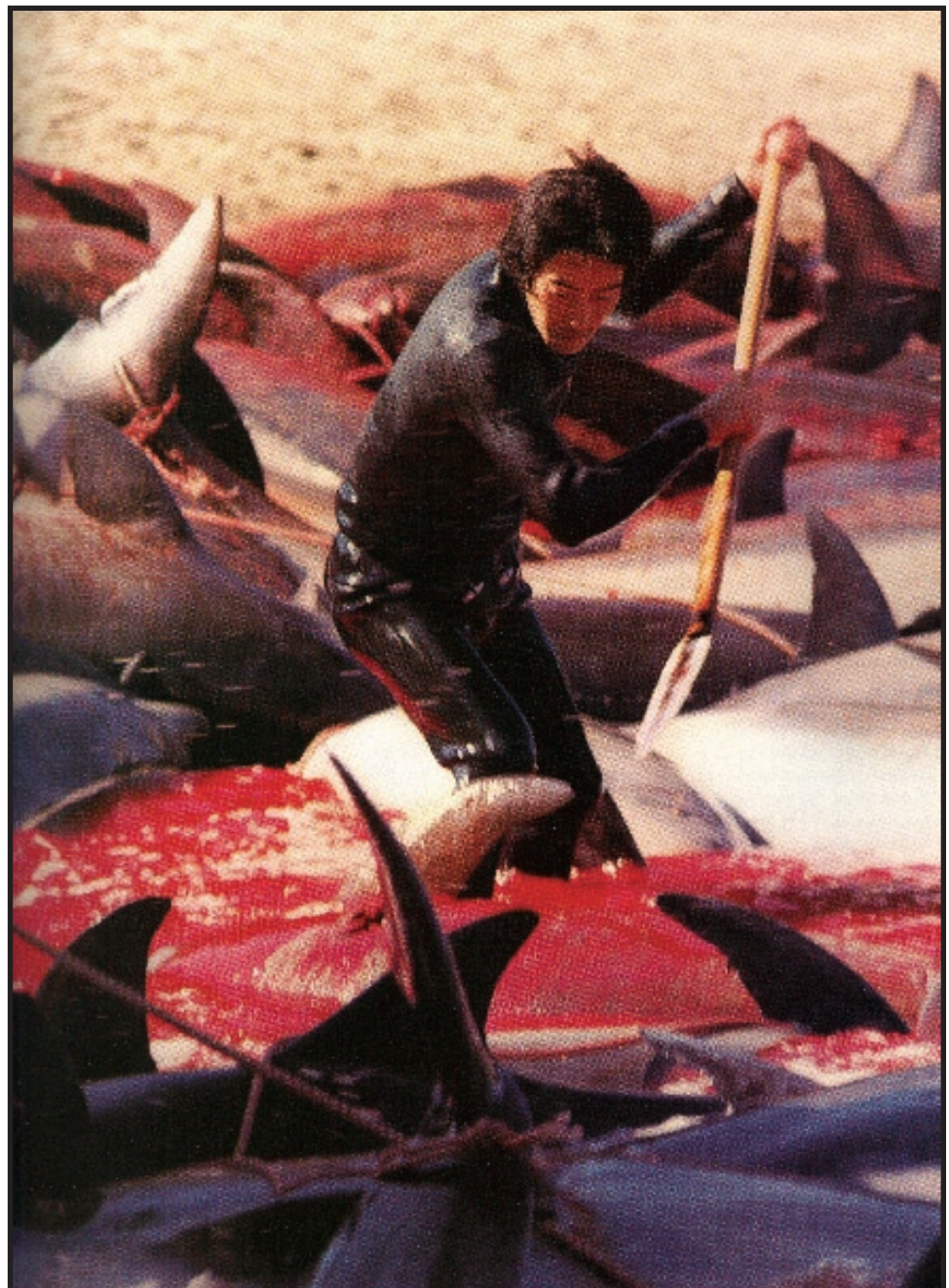

What You Can Do to Stop the Largest Slaughter of Dolphins in the World

Every year from September through April, fishermen in Japan hunt, harpoon and kill about 20,000 dolphins in the most brutal ways imaginable.

They are driven onto Japanese beaches and bays, stabbed with spears and knives, then left to slowly bleed to death turning the sea red. Others drown entangled in nets, while some are taken alive to be sold to marine parks.
